Language of the Material:	The majority of material in this collection is written in French with some materials in English.
Abstract:	The Charley Henchis Papers (approximately 1945-1987) document the career of international cabaret show producer Charley Henchis and the shows he produced in Las Vegas, Nevada and Beirut, Lebanon. Materials include Henchis' business files which includes correspondence, files on specialty acts, photographs, and press about Henchis. Shows represented in this collection includes <i>La Parisienne</i> which was performed at the Dunes Hotel in Las Vegas in 1960 before moving to Casino du Liban in Beirut. Other shows represented in this collection that were produced for Casino du Liban includes <i>Mais Oui, S'il</i> <i>Vous Plait, Flash!</i> , and <i>Hello!</i> . Additional materials include press and publicity files, music arrangements and scores, recordings of musical numbers used for the productions, and film footage of shows and production reels. Also included is film footage of the Charley Ballet, Henchis' dance troupe who were featured in his shows.

Biographical Note

Charley Henchis was a cabaret producer who was born on August 15, 1909 in Hlinaia, Moldova and grew up in the south of France. He founded the dance troupe, the Charley Ballet, who performed in his productions. In 1960, Henchis was contracted by the Dunes Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas, Nevada to produce *La Parisienne*, a revue performed in the Arabian Room. The show opened on February 18, 1960 and featured original music by Michel Legrand played by Bill Reddie & his Orchestra, and featured a cast of 80 performers from Europe. In 1961, Henchis moved to Beirut, Lebanon to produce *La Parisienne* for the Casino du Liban. Henchis produced additional shows for the Casino du Liban throughout the 1960s and 1970s including *Mais Oui, S'il Vous Plait, Hello!*, and *Flash!*.

Henchis died on July 12, 1994 in Paris, France.

Scope and Contents Note

The Charley Henchis Papers (approximately 1945-1987) document the career of international cabaret show producer Charley Henchis and the shows he produced in Las Vegas, Nevada and Beirut, Lebanon. The French spelling of Beirut (Beyrouth) is used throughout the materials. Materials include Henchis' business files which include correspondence, files on specialty acts, photographs, and press about Henchis. Shows represented in this collection includes *La Parisienne* which was performed at the Dunes Hotel in Las Vegas in 1960 before moving to Casino du Liban in Beirut. Other shows represented in this collection that were produced for Casino du Liban includes *Mais Oui, S'il Vous Plait, Flash!*, and *Hello!*. Additional materials include press and publicity files, music arrangements and scores, recordings of musical numbers used for the productions, and film footage of shows and production reels. Also included is film footage of the Charley Ballet, Henchis' dance troupe who were featured in his shows.

One 35mm film that was topically out-of-scope with the collection materials and exhibiting conservation concerns including vinegar syndrome was reviewed and securely disposed during processing.
