T. David Horton was an attorney who moved to Pioche, Nevada in the mid-1960s to represent the interests of John Janney, president of Pioche Mines Consolidated Inc. When Janney died in 1967, he left Horton property in Pioche.

Historical Background

French financier François Louis Alfred Pioche purchased land in Nevada in 1869 that became the mining town of Pioche. His heavy investment in the area helped develop the mining industries

in Pioche and other towns like Ely, Nevada. The town is the county seat of Lincoln County but its population has dwindled to approximately 1000 since the end of the mining boom.
