Biographical Note

Patricia "Pat" Craig danced in a variety of a Las Vegas, Nevada shows beginning as a Bluebell in the original 1958 edition of *Lido de Paris* at the Stardust. She continued her dance career in the *Folies Bergere* in the Tropicana from 1960 to 1965 as part of the Florence and Frederic Ballet.

Other shows she worked in the 1960s included *Casino de Paris* at the Dunes, and then at the Stardust for additional editions of the *Lido* in the 1970s including the Merci Beaucoup edition where she was a principal dancer. While attending the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, she danced as a tall nude in Jubilee from 1981 to 1982, and evenually received a Bachelor's degree in business administration in 1988. Craig later became a successful accountant working at the Mirage and MGM Mirage. Patricia Craig passed away January 2, 2017 in Las Vegas, Nevada.
