Biographical Note

Clyde F. Merrick, longtime resident of Las Vegas, Nevada, was born on July 8, 1943 to Clera Estah DeVoll Fosie. He graduated from Union High School in Tempe, Arizona in 1961 and entered the U.S. Air Force at the age of 19 and trained in electrical engineering and worked on a team that tracked the first Apollo mission from Enewetak Atoll in the Marshall Islands. After his military service, Merrick settled in Las Vegas, Nevada and worked for Reynolds Electrical and Engineering Company (REECo) as an electronics technician at the Nevada Test Site (NTS) where he maintained computers as part of the nuclear weapon testing program.

Merrick eventually left his job at NTS and began a career as a taxi cab driver in Las Vegas in the 1970s and then later began working in real estate at the age of 70. Merrick was a photography hobbyist and it is presumed that he took photographs of businesses around the Las Vegas Valley as a way to help small businesses market and promote their businesses.

Clyde F. Merrick died from cancer on August 23, 2017 in Las Vegas, Nevada.
